St Osmund's Parish Development

Our Parish was established 65 years ago thanks to the generosity and vision of generations before us. We have a duty to follow in their footsteps by ensuring that our church buildings are properly maintained and developed so that they can continue to be fit for worship and the community for years to come. An amazing total of **£450,000** has been kindly donated by parishioners and charities as of September 2023, which has allowed us to compete the first two stages of the project and to begin the third stage (upgrade the church heating system) which will start in October. The full programme can be viewed in the narthex of the Church.
