WAKE UP ... WAIT ... and WELCOME

Father Timothy Radcliffe says that 'To be AWAKE means to walk in the light of the Lord to be awake to the tiniest hints of his presence.' So what might be hints of God's presence in our daily lives? A smile from someone? A word of thanks or encouragement? The grace to forgive somebody? The generosity or a surprise from an unexpected stranger? A moment when suddenly everything becomes quiet? The driver who gives us space to change lanes? A moment of peace during our prayer time? Will you be awake to when God comes into your life unexpectedly this Advent?

And WAITING. We know the Incarnation has already happened, but we wait and long for it to be made truly flesh again in our broken and suffering world and in our own hearts - as we pray every day for peace, as we wait anxiously for good news of someone sick. And WELCOME.... Imagine a smile, an open door, an open heart to receive warmly the gift of someone's presence, no words necessary.
