### From the desk of Father Craig...

Welcome back to everyone who has been away during the Easter school break! I hope you all had a restorative time. While I had the opportunity to introduce myself during last Sunday's masses, I realize some of you might have been away. I wanted to provide a written introduction for the benefit of those who missed my initial greeting.

Firstly, I would like to extend my profound gratitude and recognition to Monsignor James Cronin for his remarkable dedication and leadership in this parish. His departure was felt deeply by many who had grown fond of his presence and guidance. Monsignor Cronin's legacy in our community is substantial, and the role he has moved into within the archdiocese is a testament to his exceptional capabilities. He leaves behind big shoes to fill, and I am humbled to step into this role following such a remarkable priest.

I completed my priestly formation at the now-defunct St John's Seminary in Wonersh, Guildford, and was ordained a priest on July 14, 2012, at St George's Cathedral. My first assignment was as the curate of the Holy Ghost Church in Balham, from my ordination until 2014. Following that, I was appointed the sub-dean of St George's Cathedral, a position I held until 2018. Most recently, I spent the last 6 years in Rome studying for a License and Doctorate in Canon Law at the Pontifical University of the Holy Cross.

St Osmund's is my first appointment as a Parish Priest, and it is with great humility and faith that I embrace this new journey. My hope and prayer are that together, with your support and prayers, we can continue to build on the strong accomplishments of Monsignor Cronin and further enrich our parish's spiritual and communal life.

In the coming weeks, I plan to host an informal gathering for everyone who serves in any capacity within our parish. This will be a wonderful opportunity for me to meet many of you personally and discuss how we can work together for the welfare and growth of our parish community.

I look forward to meeting each of you and am excited about what we will accomplish together. Thank you for welcoming me into your community; your support and prayers mean the world to me.
