**Lenten Alms**

During Lent, Bucket Collection is for the Church in Myanmar which is one of Asia's poorest countries, with over half the population living below the poverty line. In addition to supporting the Church in Myanmar we will be helping the Good Shepherd school in Phuket which educates children of parents exiled from Myanmar who are in the country illegally as without some education their life chances are severely limited. The school is run by the Good Shepherd nuns and Sister Lakana spreads herself between a dozen or so schools across Thailand. So far, the project has raised £728.27.

**Maundy Thursday Mass, 8pm**

Feet are washed during the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper as another reminder to be like Jesus. No task, no service, no gesture is beneath those who bear the name Christian. Those who have been chosen from amongst the people of God are led by the ministers to seats prepared in a suitable place. Then the Priest goes to each one, and, with the help of the ministers, pours water over each one's feet and then dries them. We need 8 volunteers. A sign-up sheet is available in the Narthex. Just one foot required from each volunteer.

**The Easter Garden of the Resurrection**

The Eco and Faith groups of our St. Osmund's school have created the Easter Garden which will beautify the sanctuary on Easter Sunday. It will help us to picture the glorious morning of discovery of Christ's empty tomb and the dawn of new life in Spring.
