Reflection

In 2022, eighteen Catholic Missionaries died violently:

Eighteen missionaries lost their lives violently across the world this year: twelve priests, one brother, three religious women, one seminarian, and one lay person. Nine missionaries were killed in Africa, eight missionaries in the Americas, and one in Asia. Most of them were assassinated not during high-risk missions, but while they were immersed and submerged in the ordinariness of their lives and their apostolic work, in the daily routine of the most habitual occupations and gestures, donated in forgetfulness of themselves and for the good of all, including – sometimes – their own executioners. Death has almost always come suddenly, caused by unmotivated violence. Sometimes, out of madness or out of ferocious ingratitude, their lives were ended by people who had only received care and laborious acts of charity from them.

Pope Francis' Prayer for Peace:

Lord God of peace, hear our prayer!

We have tried so many times and over so many years to resolve our conflicts by our own powers and by the force of our arms. How many moments of hostility and darkness have we experienced; how much blood has been shed; how many lives have been shattered; how many hopes have been buried...But our efforts have been in vain. Now, Lord, come to our aid! Grant us peace, teach us peace; guide our steps in the way of peace. Open our eyes and our hearts, and give us the courage to say: "Never again war!"; "With war everything is lost". Instil in our hearts the courage to take concrete steps to achieve peace.
