United Service

From 18 – 25 January, the Church observes eight days of prayer for Christian Unity. It is a time when the six churches in Barnes (ourselves, the three Church of England congregations, the Baptist and Methodist) come together in prayer.

This year, the United Service takes place at St Mary's at 4.00pm on Sunday 23 January. Speaking to the World Council of Churches, Pope Francis in 2018 said: "Divisions between Christians have often arisen because at their root a worldly mindset has seeped in. First self-concern took priority over concern for Christ and from there, it was easy for the devil to move in, separating us."

Three years ago when St Osmund's was host we invited Mgr Nizar Semaan to preach. Soon after Pope Francis appointed him and he was ordained Archbishop in his home city of Qaraqosh in the north of Iraq; Archbishop of the Syriac Catholic Community. Before ISIS, there were 50,000 Catholics. However half the city left during the ISIS invasion – many to Europe, others to Baghdad, Kurdistan and elsewhere. It is difficult to know the current situation. Please pray for Archbishop Nizar.
