I was regretting the past and fearing the future. Suddenly my Lord was speaking:

“My Name is **I AM**”

He paused. I waited. He continued, “When you live in the past with all its mistakes and regrets, it is hard.

**I AM** not there.

My name is not **I WAS**.

When you live in the future, with all its problems and fears, it is hard.

**I AM** not there.

My name is not **I WILL BE**.

When you live in this present moment it is not hard. **I AM** here.

My name is **I AM**.

**Children's Liturgy Group**

For two age groups: 2 - 4 year olds (parents may accompany), and 4 - 7 year olds (with whom parents are asked not to accompany). Please ensure your child is signed in each week so we have a correct register should there be an emergency. The Children's Mass is celebrated the first Sunday of every month.

**Going into hospital** If you are admitted to the hospital and require the services of the Catholic Chaplain please ask the ward Nurse to arrange this for you and in many cases insist. NHS Chaplaincy Guidelines 2015 state: For reasons of both pastoral, spiritual or religious care and equality, providers should make every effort to request and record data about religion or belief. In order to have the information needed to provide excellent spiritual care it is essential that all NHS patients and service users be asked if they wish to declare their religion or belief and to have this recorded.
